Museum Limited Release 1999 Sangiovese

Our 1999 Sangiovese is now 10 years old and it's drinking so well that we've decided to re-release it. This is a rare opportunity to taste a ten year old, Hunter Valley Sangiovese. It will be very difficult to find another one! It will be a dinner table show stopper a wonderful wine you may be stunned at what the top wine reviewers would rate this at. This is a great example of modern Australian lighter style wine. We have limited cases, orders will be filled on a first come first served basis.

2005 Sangiovese

The result of our Sangiovese vines that are now over 10 years old, the 2005 Sangiovese is drinking very well now and will benefit from continued bottle age as is evident in the 1999 and 2000 Sangiovese. It is available at some great restaurants like Intermezzo and Pendolino.

2006 Semillon

The 2002 and 2004 Semillon were listed in the "Best of the Best Semillons" by James Halliday in his 2005 and 2006 Wine Companions. We've been too busy of late to submit our recent wines for review but Andrew Spinazie ("Spinner") still makes our outstanding Semillon with grapes picked from 50 plus year-old non-irrigated vines at the base of the Brokenback range. The wine is crisp with a nice balanced acid and floral nose. It develops well in the bottle to become a golden toasty Semillon for which the Hunter Valley is famous.

2007 Semillon

Following on in the great tradition of the "best of the best" is the 2007 Semillon on its debut. De Beyers Vineyard is one of the great Hunter Valley vineyards with an impeccable history and wine pedigree that is obvious in this wine.

2008 Semillon

This newer, crisper, citrus style Semillon is often a great favourite of many, particularly in summer. It will be like the others and will cellar beautifully.

2005 Shiraz

We have very limited cases of this super premium Shiraz. Normally these grapes have gone into the top of the Tyrells range which is understandable given many of the grapes come from vines 50 years old producing small quantities of the finest grapes. The 2003 Shiraz sold out soon after release, 2005 is drinking beautifully now and will benefit from cellaring for drinking in 2012 and beyond. This is a great chance to purchase a very limited release (approx 50 cases) of a very special Shiraz.

2006 Shiraz

Another fine example of a premium Hunter Valley Shiraz from these aged vines. Drinking well now but will benefit from cellaring for drinking in 2014. This again is a very limited release of only 100 cases available from this vintage.

Ragamuffin

The literal translation of Ragamuffin is dirty little child/naughty little child which seemed to be a very appropriate name to give this wine in view of the two new dirty little wine makers in the Colvin family, Emily and Alistair (the picture on the label is Emily). This is a wine designed for drinking at an earlier age, however it is doing well with some bottle age. It is a careful blending of Sangiovese, Merlot and Shiraz, which is keenly priced for the quality and is a wonderful accompaniment to everyday food.

San Rosé

It is a dry, fruity wine that has a sweet start and a dry finish. Served chilled and enjoy with friends and family anytime. If you like Rose you will like this easy drinking variety. It is designed to drink now not to cellar. Enjoy now and drink over summer.
